CEMI's Use of Information Policy






CONTEXT

It is recognized that in the course of its business, CEMI has legitimate business and legal requirements for the collection, use, and disclosure of personal information. CEMI respects individual rights to privacy and, in order to give this effect, commits to administer the collection, disclosure and use of personal information in accordance with this policy and [Canada's Personal Information Protection and Electronics Document Act \(The Act\)](#).

This policy applies to all personnel (employees, contract workers, contractors, consultants and others doing work on behalf of CEMI) of CEMI. This policy also applies to all individuals whose personal information CEMI collects uses or discloses in the course of doing business.

For the purposes of this policy, "personal information" means information about an identifiable individual, including a person's name, title, business address or telephone number.

Some additional examples of personal information are:

-  Race, national or ethnic origin, colour, religion, age or marital status
-  Medical, educational, financial, employment and criminal history
-  Address and identifying numbers assigned to the individual/employee
-  Correspondence with CEMI that is explicitly or implicitly of a private nature
-  Views or opinions concerning an employee/individual, compensation, and succession planning information





The following policy statements apply to all personal information that is collected, used or disclosed by the Company. The Company has designated the Operations Manager to be accountable for the operation of this policy. Individuals may question or report any privacy concerns, breaches, violations or compliance issues to the CEMI Operations Manager.


PURPOSE


To systematically apply a clear, transparent, use of personal Information supplied to CEMI

PROCESS

CEMI may collect personal information for the purposes of:

-  administering CEMI membership and providing member services;
-  notifying CEMI members of upcoming events and new services;
-  registering for CEMI short courses, workshops and events;
-  managing newsletter subscriptions;

 developing CEMI's internal (private) expert database, to help develop expert teams, and for select workshop / RFP invitations;

 processing and administering the above or other purposes as necessary.

CEMI will not use personal information for any other purpose than identified above. Your contact information will not be shared without your permission.

If you have voluntarily provided information, you have consented to the collection, use and disclosure of your personally identifiable information as described in this privacy policy. CEMI will not use personal information for any purpose other than that for which you consented. Should CEMI require personal information for a new purpose, we will contact you to seek consent for that new use.

CEMI does not sell or trade any personal information with third parties (e.g. in the administration of event registrations). CEMI may transfer information to outsourced administrative service providers. Where personal information is transferred to a service provider for processing, we require the service provider to respect this Privacy Policy and we restrict them from using or disclosing personal information transferred to them for any purpose other than the provision of services to us.

Any personal information that CEMI retains is kept in such a manner as to ensure its security and confidentiality at all times.
